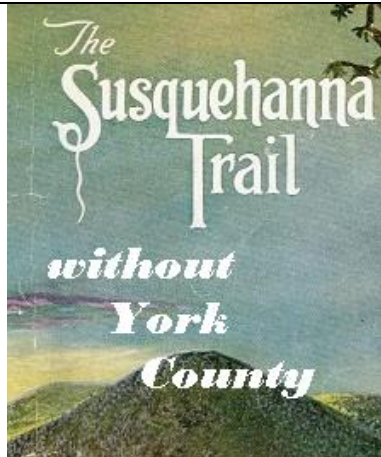


2017 NEYCHIP PRESENTATIONS
