Strinestown and Zion View

Strinestown – The original name of this town was Mt. Pleasant but it was frequently referred to as Strine's town after an early land owner. When the post office was established in 1849, there being another Mt. Pleasant in Pennsylvania, the name Strinestown was used by the postal service. The post office was discontinued in 1863 and reestablished on November 22, 1869. Closing for good on February 15, 1910, the area is currently serviced by the Manchester Post Office.



Zion View – The post office in Zion View opened in 1894 and closed in 1905. The post office was located at what is now 88 Copenhaffer Road. Zion View currently has a York address.

The addresses of Conewago Township are now York, Dover, Manchester and York Haven.
