The Mount Wolf Borough would like to congratulate John Moramarco for achieving his Professional Certification in Emergency Management. This is the highest degree of a 3-tier certification granted by the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Agency. Mr. Moramarco got involved in EMA back in the mid 1990's. He became EMA coordinator for Northeastern Area EMA in 2002. Northeastern EMA is a cooperative merger of Mount Wolf Borough, Manchester Borough, and East Manchester Township to share EMA staff and resources.

Mr. Moramarco has spent his whole life involved in emergency services. At age 16, he joined the Thomasville Fire Department where he also ran with its ambulance. He worked in EMS in West York and spent 12 years as a police officer, which includes an 11-year stint in Federal Law Enforcement.

When asked why he volunteers for the Northeastern Area EMA, John said; "It's my way of giving something back to the community. We all receive a lot from the community and God and I enjoy giving back. It's the satisfaction that you've made a difference."
